- Participate for fun and for yourself.
- Be punctual for training and matches.
- Wear the correct clothing as specified by your coaches.
- Bad language will not be tolerated.
- Report for training and matches with clean boots and shin pads.
- Play to the laws of the game and NEVER question a referee's decision.
- Co-operate with and RESPECT your coaches – when given instruction, listen and act appropriately. If you wish to discuss matters or would like an explanation for your coach's actions, speak to them after the session.
- Control your temper and keep playing regardless of the score and your own form, everybody will benefit.
- Treat all players including opponents with RESPECT.
- Shake hands after the game – your reaction to winning or losing should be the same.
- The main aim of training sessions and matches is to improve your own game.
- While you cannot play like professionals – “yet” – you can always behave in a professional manner on and off the pitch.
- Wear the “TORQUESPEED” name with pride.

- Do not force your child to participate.
- Children should play for themselves.
- The right application, attitude and effort are more important than anything else.
- Lead by example – show RESPECT to coaches and referees and NEVER question decisions.
- Allow children to learn without the pressure of results and winning.
- Never shout at a player for losing or making mistakes – let them learn from these experiences.
- Recognise good play from both teams.
- Bad language has no place in football.
- Enjoy the football – regardless of the result.
- Remember the players are not mini professionals and allow them to have fun.
